



Florida-Compliant HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices  
Inspire and Beyond ABA  
Effective Date: April 21, 2025

This notice explains how medical information about your child may be collected, used, and disclosed, and how you can access this information. Please read it carefully.

Inspire and Beyond ABA is committed to safeguarding the privacy of your child's Protected Health Information (PHI). We are legally required to maintain privacy, follow the terms of this Notice, and explain our legal duties and privacy practices. PHI includes demographic and clinical information that identifies your child and relates to their physical or mental health or payment for healthcare.

We may use or disclose PHI without your written authorization for treatment, payment, and healthcare operations. For example, we coordinate care with other providers, bill insurance or third-party payers, and conduct internal quality assurance, audits, accreditation, training, or certification activities. We also comply with state and federal laws-such as those requiring us to report suspected child abuse, neglect, or threats of harm-and we may act to prevent serious threats to health or safety. Information may be disclosed to trusted business associates (e.g., billing vendors or data management platforms), provided they are contractually bound to preserve confidentiality.

Certain uses and disclosures do require your written authorization. This includes PHI used for marketing, the sale of PHI, release of psychotherapy notes (when kept separately from treatment records), or any other purposes not specified in this Notice. You may revoke that authorization in writing at any time.

You have specific rights regarding your child's PHI. You may request to inspect or obtain copies of records, request an amendment of inaccurate or incomplete information, and receive an accounting of our disclosures. You may also ask for confidential communications-for instance, to be contacted at a specific address or phone number-and request restrictions on how PHI is used or shared. We will honor feasible requests when permitted by law. You are entitled to receive a paper copy of this Notice whenever you wish.

Pursuant to Florida Statute §456.057, we provide heightened protections around psychotherapy and mental health records. We will always comply with these state-specific rules before releasing such information. Should a breach of unsecured PHI occur, you will receive prompt notification as required by federal and Florida regulations.

If you believe your privacy rights have been violated, you may file a complaint with us-Inspire and Beyond ABA-or with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office for Civil Rights at [www.hhs.gov/ocr/privacy/hipaa/complaints/](http://www.hhs.gov/ocr/privacy/hipaa/complaints/). You will not be penalized for filing a complaint.

We reserve the right to amend this Notice at any time. Changes will apply to all PHI we maintain now or receive in the future. Updated versions will be available at our office and on our website.
